- › Completed Application Form
- › Cover Letter describing your interest in NSLT (1 page)
- › Resume
- › Statement of Faith (1 page)
- › A Recent Photograph (that could be used as a headshot on IJM.org if selected)

## Statement of Faith

All IJM candidates must be in agreement with the Apostles' Creed and subscribe to an orthodox Christian faith.

Please describe your Christian faith and how it is relevant to your involvement with IJM. This statement should:

- › Outline your spiritual journey
- › Discuss your current spiritual disciplines (prayer, study, etc.),
- › Include your current place of worship.

# THE DETAILS

## Application Details

- › Applications are due to [chapters@ijm.org](mailto:chapters@ijm.org) by January 31.
- › IJM does not send confirmation emails upon receipt of your application.
- › Not all applicants will be selected. If NOT selected, you may apply again the following year.
- › Applicants will be contacted for scheduling of initial interview times in February.

## Leadership Development:

- › Part of your leadership development will be reading selected books, articles, and discussion participation. It is important for each member to participate fully in order to maximize everyone's experience.
- › Each team member will have the opportunity for 1-1 mentoring and conversations with IJM team members.

## Field Office Trip:

- › The IJM Field Office trip will take place in the summer (typically the first 2 weeks of August) before the school year in which you serve.
- › A valid Passport will be required for international travel.
- › The cost of the trip will be between \$1500-\$2000 plus airfare. Members will raise support to cover the cost of the trip.
